

Muchea Sheep Report 05/08/2025

Yarding 9,391/ sheep 4,551 / lambs 4,840

Numbers were up for a total of 9,391 sheep and lambs at Muchea. Quality eased on last week with prices reflecting. Most categories eased \$5 to \$10 with buyers selective. A good line up of heavy lambs offered reach a top of \$307 while mutton eased \$5 to \$10 on last weeks gain.

New season light weight lambs made \$52 to \$198 while trade weights sold to \$220 /head.

Old season lambs weighing under 16kg cwt sold from \$74 to \$166 while heavier lambs made \$132 to \$199/head. Trade weight lambs were selling from \$180 to \$242 and heavy weight lambs sold to \$307/head. A large selection of ram lambs made from \$140 to \$290, weight dependent.

Xbred hoggets returned \$166 to \$224 for heavy weights.

Light weight Merino wether hoggets ranged from \$118 to \$160 while heavy weights sold from \$212 to \$223/head. Ewe hoggets returned \$149 for light weights, medium weights made from \$170 to \$180 while heavier prime ewes sold to \$235/head.

Store mutton made from \$86 to \$160 while the prime medium weight ewes returned \$160 to \$200 and heavy weight ewes over 30kg cwt sold from \$188 to \$242/head. Mature wethers made \$160 for store lines while medium and heavy weights sold from \$180 to \$238/head. Mature rams sold from \$30 to \$172 head.
