

Muchea Cattle Report 30/09/2025

1,507 liveweight and 16 veal / total 1,523

Numbers were consistent with previous weeks with Quality local cattle in all categories and big lines of pastoral cows and calves. Most categories lifted today and those that did not remained firm. Heifers in particular were in demand gaining up to 30c/kg with a full buying field filling orders.

Local weaner steers were selling from 300c to 472c while lightweight weaner heifers started from 150c up to 412c with more cover. Local yearling steers sold from 384c to 440c while yearling heifers returned 208c through to a top of 430c gaining 15c/kg. Pastoral steer calves started from 50c up to 400c while pastoral heifers ranged from 134c to 378c/kg.

Grown steers returned 388c to 426c while grown heifers returned 362c to 414c/kg. Store cows made 98c to 316c while heavier cows sold from 320c to 356c/kg.

Heavy bulls were back slightly selling from 226c to 328c/kg.
