

Muchea Cattle Report 27/01/2026

1132 liveweight and 30 veal / total 1162

Cattle numbers remained fair today with 1162 after the long weekend.

The sale consisted of good quality trade steers, big lines of fat and store cows while lines of weaners and yearlings dropped off a little in quality. Quality determined price fluctuations to overall remain equal.

Local weaner steers were selling from 300c to 500c while weaner heifers were making 250c to 380c/kg. Local yearling steers sold from 320c to 410c while yearling heifers returned 250c to 366c/kg.

Grown steers ranged from 240c to 382c while grown heifers returned 356c to 364c/kg. Store cows sold from 122c to 308c while medium weight cows returned 260c to 358c and heavy cows sold to a top of 336c/kg.

Shipping bulls sold from 250c to 334c and heavy bulls ranged from 220c to 284c/kg.
