



## Muchea Sheep Report 03/02/2026

### *Yarding 8,570/ sheep 4,279 / lambs 4,291*

Numbers were up for a total yarding of 8570 mainly good quality sheep and lambs at Muchea. Heavy lambs eased with heavier weight offered than last week while trade weight lambs held firm and less demand on light and store lambs saw prices back marginally. Live export and processor demand pushed hogget values while a good yarding of mutton was firm on last week and mature rams eased in numbers and value.

Plain store lambs sold from \$50 to \$139 for better types while light lambs made \$176 to \$200/head. Trade weights returned \$199 to \$240 while heavy lambs sold from \$240 to \$308/head.

Merino wether hoggets made \$211 to \$226 , Merino ewe hoggets were making \$120 to \$180 and Crossbred hoggets with weight returned \$210 to \$245/head.

Mutton was firm with boning ewes ranging from \$65 to \$179 while medium weights returned \$160 to \$220 and heavy ewes sold to a top of \$259/head. Heavy wethers made \$169 to \$260 while mature rams to processors sold from \$50 to \$208/head.
