



Muceha Cattle Report 09/02/2026

939 liveweight and 0 veal / total 939

Today's sale total halved from last week's sale with a yarding of 936. There was no veal sale today as agents sold the odd calf under 200kgs in the liveweight pens. Today's market was mostly made up of lightweight weaners, store cows and limited fat cows on offer as well as a light run of yearling and grown animals. Weaner steers lifted in values pushing 500c/kg on light weights while weaner heifers were back 10c mainly due to an easing in quality. Store cows held firm on recent gains while heavier cows eased 15/20c/kg with a full buying field operating.

Local weaner steers were selling from 350c to 496c while weaner heifers were making 250c to 382c/kg. Local yearling steers weighing under 400kg sold from 370c to 412c and heavier weights from 240c to 392c/kg. Yearling heifers under 400kg were selling from 250c to 372c and over 400kg from 300c to 380c/kg. Pastoral steer calves sold from 304c to 320c while pastoral heifers ranged from 250c to 350c/kg.

Grown steers returned 290c to 366c while grown heifers were selling from 300c to 354c/kg.

Store cows sold from 160c to 314c while heavy cows easing 15/20c with Medium to heavy weight cows selling from 270c to 330c/kg.

Shipping bulls were making 244c to 368c and heavy bulls eased 20/25c ranging from 250c to 290c/kg.
