



## Muceha Cattle Report 16/02/2026

*1469 liveweight and 10 veal / total 1479*

Numbers increased to nearly 1500 cattle today after last week's lighter offering. The sale consisted mostly of weaner steers and heifers along with big runs of cows while other categories were limited in supply. Heavy cow prices lifted 10c while plainer cows remained firm as did weaner steers while weaner heifers eased 8/10c in value with a full buying field in operation. Shipping bulls gained 20c and heavy bulls also lifted 15/20c/kg.

Local weaner steers depending on cover ranged from 300c to 476c while weaner heifers were making 230c to 382c/kg. The limited supply of local yearling steers returned 280c to 404c while yearling heifers also few in number, sold from 250c to 386c/kg. There were only several pens of pastoral steer calves selling from 300c to 350c and pastoral heifers ranged from 264c to 350c/kg.

Low volumes of grown steers ranged from 258c to 380c while grown heifers returned 310c to 400c/kg.

Store cows made from 160c up to 292c while medium cows returned 280c to 342c and heavy cows sold to a top of 340c/kg.

Plain bulls back to paddocks sold from 230c to 338c while bulls suited for shipping lifted 30c making 278c to 360c and heavy bulls gained 15/20c ranging from 250c to 308c/kg.
