



Muceha Sheep Report 17/03/2026

Yarding 10,762/ sheep 3,744 / lambs 7,018

Trade and heavy lambs continue to come forward at Muceha as well as large lines of store lambs lifting the total to just short of 1100 head. Lambs made up a large proportion of the sale as well as approximately 2500 ewes. The buyer gallery was crowded with the usual processors, several feedlot buyers and eastern states interest as well as a big crowd of onlookers. Most lamb and mutton categories again recorded slight gains, with the exception of heavy lambs easing \$10/12/head. Store lambs sold between 1000/1200c/kg cwt while heavier lambs recorded 950/1050c/kg cwt.

Light framed store lambs started from \$40 and with bigger frames sold up to \$198, while light lambs made \$160 to \$228/head. Trade weights returned \$191 to \$240, while heavy lambs eased with cwt's from 23/26kg making \$231 to \$260 and extra heavy lambs sold to a top of \$296/head.

Merino wether hoggets sold from \$190 to \$250 and Merino ewe hoggets were making \$170 to \$210/head. Crossbred hoggets showing good finish returned \$165 to \$231 and younger rams sold to a top of \$280/head.

Boning ewes were making \$80 to \$175 while medium weights lifted \$4-5 to return \$180 to \$236 and heavy ewes sold to a top of \$260, gaining \$6/8/head. Heavy wethers ranged from \$185 to \$240 while mature rams sold from \$60 to \$190/head.
