



Muceha Cattle Report 20/04/2026

1020 liveweight and 6 veal / total 1026

It was a mixed sale today with a fair range of local yearlings and weaners as well as runs of mixed quality pastoral calves. Cows and trade weight steers and heifers were light in supply and only one local heavy bull was offered. The buyer gallery was well represented with several restockers and feedlot buyers from southern areas in attendance keeping values up on recent highs.

Local weaner steers were selling from 300c to 554c while weaner heifers started from 264c and sold up to 510c/kg. Local yearling steers weighing under 400kg returned 330c to 512c and heavier weights from 396c to 428c/kg. Yearling heifers under 400kg were selling from 240c to 476c and with more weight also sold to a top of 476c/kg. Pastoral steer calves were mixed in condition and made 240c up to 432c, while pastoral heifers also presented in a wide range of condition started from 196c up to 430c for the better types.

Grown steers were limited in number and returned 338c to 428c to gain 20c, while grown heifers lifted 10c to return 394c to 436c/kg. Store cows sold from 150c to 292c, while medium weight cows returned 288c to 330c and heavy cows sold to a top of 364c/kg.

Young bulls ranged from 220c to 358c, while heavy pastoral bulls sold from 230c to 364c and only one local heavy bull yarded making 340c/kg.
