



## Muchea Sheep Report 12/05/2026

*Yarding 9,398/ sheep 2,099 / lambs 7,299*

Lamb supplies were again around the 7000 mark while sheep numbers fell away by 1500 head. Similar to last week there were good runs of finished heavy lambs off feed and several lanes of trade weights as well as many large drafts of Merino store lambs. The buying field was full and bidding was strong pushing values on most lamb categories up \$5-6 and heavy lambs were dearer by \$8/10/head. Heavy Mutton also gained momentum with slight gains on lighter ewes while heavy ewes lifted by \$10/15.

Store lambs started from \$90 up to \$213 while light lambs made \$180 to \$236/head. Trade weights returned \$210 to \$247 while heavy lambs sold from \$250 to \$303 and like last week there was a single extra heavy lamb that realized \$340. Ram lambs were also selling well with heavy weights making \$230 to \$301/head.

Store Merino wether hoggets started from \$120 up to \$210 with improvement and the same for light Merino ewe hoggets starting from \$146 up to \$255 with weight. Finished Crossbred hoggets returned \$201 to \$268 and younger rams sold to a top of \$262/head.

Boning ewes were making \$127 to \$185 while medium weights returned \$180 to \$230 and heavy ewes sold to a top of \$260/head. Heavy wethers ranged from \$202 to \$239 while mature rams sold from \$50 to \$150/head.
