



## Muceha Cattle Report 22/09/2025

*1932 liveweight and 59 veal / total 1991*

Today's sale was predominantly a yearling and weaner sale with light supplies of Trade weight steers and heifers as well as shorter numbers of cows. Feedlot buyers from both Northern and southern areas were amongst the regular buying group ensuring a very strong sale with gains in most categories of younger cattle.

Local weaner steers gained 40/50c starting from 340c with most lots selling from 450c to 550c while weaner heifers lifted 30/35c making 300c to 514c/kg. Local yearling steers under 400kg were dearer by 30/40c to return 404c to 534c and heavier weights were firm selling from 396c to 482c/kg. Yearling heifers under 400kg also lifted 30/40c making 300c to 502c and with more weight and frame sold from 400c to 442c/kg. Pastoral steer calves showing cover ranged from 350c to 474c while pastoral heifers made 150c to 412c over a wider range of condition.

Grown steers returned 316c to 428c while the few grown heifers yarded realized 364c to 400c/kg.

Store cows gained 10/15c selling from 150c to 314c while medium and heavy cows eased 5/10c to return 300c to 336c for medium weights and heavy cows sold to a top of 360c/kg.

Young bulls back to paddocks or to exporters made 250c to 370c while heavy bulls sold from 250c to 344c/kg.
