



Muchea Cattle Report 02/06/2026

767 liveweight and 32 veal / total 799

Large drafts of pastoral store steers and heifers made up a high portion of today's sale along with several smaller runs of trade and feeder weight local cattle. Quality was back on local steers and heifers from past sales with values holding firm. The buying field was crowded resulting in pastoral calves selling well while the few cows available showing condition lifted 10c/kg.

Local weaner steers were selling from 250c to 514c while weaner heifers started from 120c up to 458c/kg. Local yearling steers returned 340c to 480c while yearling heifers were selling from 278c to 494c/kg. Pastoral store steer calves sold from 236c to 412c while pastoral heifers ranged from 232c up to 416c/kg.

Grown steers returned from 280c to 480c while grown heifers returned 380c to 414c/kg. The limited store cows were making 220c to 276c while heavier cows lifted selling from 300c to 374 c/kg.

Young bulls ranged from 180c to 394c quality dependent and the one local bull yarded realized 318c/kg.
