



Muchea Sheep Report 30/06/2026

Yarding 4278 / sheep 1527 / lambs 2751

Numbers were down for a total yarding of 4278 sheep and lambs at Muchea. A very mixed quality yarding with prices generally trending up with processor / feeder demand and low numbers on offer. Extra heavy lambs sold to \$342 while mutton gained with all processors in action to top at \$280 for ewes and \$317 for a pen of wethers carrying a full fleece.

Lambs weighing under 16kg cwt sold from \$75 to \$185 while weights under 18kg cwt made up to \$240/head. Trade weight lambs sold from \$220 to \$261 while heavy lambs sold from \$254 to \$321 and weights over 30kg cwt made up to \$342/head. Ram lambs made from \$130 to \$338 for the heaviest.

A small yarding of Merino wether hoggets made \$180 for stores while heavy weights sold for \$212 to \$260/head. Heavy Crossbred hoggets returned \$242 to \$263/head.

Store ewes sold from \$76 to \$213 with a fleece while medium and heavy weights returned \$170 to \$280/head. Heavy wethers sold from \$215 to \$317 while mature rams ranged from \$80 to \$208/head.
