

Muchea Sheep Report 14/07/2026

Yarding 6,491/ sheep 1,479/ lambs 5,012

Numbers were up for a total yarding of 6491 sheep and lambs at Muchea. Lambs once again dominated the numbers with prices trending up with demand. Extra heavy weight lambs sold to \$316/head. The small offering of sheep categories saw most classes gain with demand with heavy ewe mutton selling to \$270 while wethers topped at \$300/head. One pen of new season lambs sold for \$278/head.

Old season Lambs weighing under 16kg cwt sold from \$120 to \$188 while weights under 18kg cwt made up to \$228/head. Trade weight lambs sold from \$197 to \$265 while heavier lambs sold from \$250 to \$316/head. Good numbers of ram lambs continued to gain with demand selling from \$160 to \$340 for the heaviest.

A small yarding of Merino wether hoggets made \$144 to \$205 for stores while heavy weights sold to \$258/head. Merino ewe hoggets sold from \$239 to \$255/head. Heavy Crossbred hoggets returned \$170 to \$261/head.

Low numbers of store ewes sold from \$140 to \$170 while medium weights made up to \$220 and heavy weights returned \$220 to \$270/head. Mature wethers sold from \$190 to \$300 while mature rams ranged from \$125 to \$240/head.
