COVID -19 Update - 31 March

The Muchea Livestock Centre continues to be restricted to only essential personnel, these being:

- Pre-Registered Agents
- Pre-Registered Buyers
- Pre-Registered Transporters
- Pre-Registered Contractors and,
- Pre–Registered WAMIA staff

As of Monday 6 April, only buyers who have pre-registered with an agent will be permitted entry. The agents will provide a list of registered buyers that will be held at the front gate and if your name is not on the list you will not be admitted. Please take the time to pre-register this week.

In addition:

- Agents will have a maximum of four pre-registered selling staff attend sales and Senior Management will enforce this rule,
- Maximum of one transport co-ordinator present at the sale,
- Buyer laneways to be monitored by WAMIA to ensure that only active buyers are present,
- WAMIA will be restricting access to their saleyard office to ensure social distancing takes place, and agents will do the same.

This means that members of the general public and vendors will **n**ot be able gain entry. This is in line with Health Department advice and in line with the actions of other saleyards around Australia.

We ask that you reconsider your need to attend sales at the Muchea Livestock Centre. We will be strictly enforcing social distancing rules and non-compliance will lead to people being required to leave the facility.
