



## **MUCHEA CATTLE SALE 12/9/22**

Yarding 835 - down 331

Numbers were back but a better-quality yarding was presented. Prices trending up in all categories with increased demand. Heavy bulls sold to 348c up 12c & heavy cows topped at 360c to remain firm on last week. A pen of weaner steers topped the market at 592c/kg.

Local bred weaner steers sold from 516c to 592c while weaner heifers made 400c to 540c for local bred lines and pastoral heifers returned 382c to 418c /kg. Local bred yearling steers made 420c to 524c and yearling heifers sold for 330c to 478c depending on quality & pastoral lines made from 264c to 410c /kg.

Grown steers including pastorals made from 340c to 470c to processors and feeder buyers. Heavy weight grown heifers sold to processors for 372c to 396c /kg.

Heavy prime cows were firm at 300c to 360c while medium weights made 276c to 350c /kg. Store cows sold to processors for 240c to 312c and feeder /restocker buyers paid 248c to 320/kg.

Heavy bulls made from 286c to 348c, medium weights sold from 316c to 358c and light weight bulls returned from 280c to 484c depending on quality to live export, feeder & restocker buyers.
