

MUCHEA CATTLE SALE 27/9/22

Yarding- 852 - down 1,208

Numbers were down up with a mixed quality yarding dominated by pastoral bulls and heifers. Weaner steers sold to 572c while heifers topped at 560c/kg. The large yarding of bulls lifted with demand from processors and live export. All categories of cows were up with the small numbers offered.

Local bred weaner steers sold from 390c to 572c while weaner heifers made 450c to 560c for local bred lines and pastoral heifers returned 240c to 295c /kg. Local bred yearling steers made 422c to 520c and yearling heifers sold for 330c to 450c & pastoral lines made from 220c to 380c in a lower quality yarding.

Grown steers including pastorals made from 310c to 418c to processors and 300c to 422c to feeder buyers. Grown heifers gained selling for 300c to 460c /kg.

Light numbers of cows saw heavy prime cows sell for 312c while medium weights made 260c to 308c /kg. Store cows sold for 120c to 270c /kg.

Heavy bulls made from 282c to 330c while medium weights sold from 260c to 370c and light weight bulls returned from 236c to 510c depending on quality.
