

MUCHEA SHEEP AND LAMB REPORT 27/9/22

Total Yarding: 2457 (-1157) | Sheep Yarding: 1457 (-922) | Lamb Yarding: 1000 (-235)

A small mixed quality yarding again dominated by mutton. Prices trended down with all sectors of buyers very selective. New season lambs topped at \$167 while the heaviest old season lambs returned \$125/head. Heavy mutton sold to \$150/head carrying a fleece.

New season light weight lambs made from \$50 to \$113, trade weights returned \$95 to \$150 and heavy weights sold to \$167/head. Ram lambs made from \$40 to \$90/head for the heaviest. Young Merino wethers sold from \$81 to \$120 and the ewes from \$95 to \$100/head.

Mutton eased with store ewes selling from \$31 to \$72, prime medium weight ewes returned \$95 to \$111 and heavy ewes sold for \$100 to \$150/head with a fleece. Mature rams sold from \$40 to \$81 to processors to finish down \$20/head.
