



## **MUCHEA CATTLE SALE 03/10/22**

Yarding- 1,322 – up 470 head

Numbers were up for a mixed quality yarding. Cows were in demand finishing up 30c/kg in all categories while weaner steers sold to 602c and heifers topped at 550c/kg.

Local bred weaner steers sold from 440c to 602c while weaner heifers made 384c to 550c for local bred lines and pastoral heifers returned from 300c to 460c/kg. Local bred yearling steers made 428c to 500c and yearling heifers sold for 340c to 490c/kg. Pastoral lines made from 390c to 438c/kg.

Bullocks weighing over 750kg made 360c while lighter weights returned 382c to 400c/kg. Grown steers including pastorals weighing under 600kg sold from 320c to 488c/kg. Grown heifers made 320c to 394c/kg.

An excellent run of heavy prime cows sold for 296c to 364c/kg while medium weights made from 298c to 346c and store cows gained, selling from 220c to 292c/kg.

Heavy bulls were back selling from 280c to 348c while medium weights sold from 240c to 374c and light weight bulls returned 244c to 510c/kg, quality dependent.
