



## **MUCHEA CATTLE SALE 24/10/22**

Yarding- 1,205– down 642 head

Numbers dropped this week with 1117 liveweight and 88 calves for a total of 1205. Again, the sale was dominated by pastoral cattle with big lines of heavy steers and cows. Supplies of local cattle were limited with some well finished young cattle but mostly suited to feedlots and restockers. The sale started a little slow with cow values but picked up as the sale went on.

Local Vealer steers sold from 450c to 564c and local vealer heifers were selling from 355c to 466c/kg. Yearling steers to restockers and feedlots selling from 332c to 544c while young restocker heifers sold up to 472c/kg. Well-conditioned yearling steers returned 319c to 442c while prime yearling heifers sold up to 464c/kg.

Heavy grown steers sold up to 480c, grown heifers sold from 308c to 448c/kg. Boner cows were making 150c to 242c, medium cows selling up to 314c while heavy cows sold to 328 c/kg

Light weight bulls sold from 260c to 505c, shipping bulls were selling from 296c to 388c/kg and Mature bulls returned 250c to 352c/kg.
