



MUCHEA CATTLE SALE 7/11/22

Yarding 1,466 – down 567

Numbers were down by 567 with 1421 liveweight and 41 calves for a total of 1466. A higher percentage of younger cattle were on offer this week with an even mix of both local and pastoral cattle so the presence of a few extra buyers in the restocker market provided some good competition. Mature bulls were down 20c/kg and the cow market started off slow but recovered as the sale continued.

Local Vealer steers were making from 442c to 620c for better types and vealer heifers sold up to 550c/kg. Young steers to restockers selling from 210c to 466c depending on breed and quality while young restocker heifers sold up to 400c/kg. Feeder steers made 350c to 586c feeder heifers returned up to 478c/kg.

Grown steers selling from 258c to 386c and Grown heifers sold from 250c to 438c/kg. Light weight cows were making up to 180c, medium cows selling up to 240c while heavy cows returned 330c/kg

Mature heavy bulls sold to 290c and shipping bulls were selling from 242c to 492c while light restocker bulls sold up to 540c/kg
