



MUCHEA CATTLE SALE 14/11/22

Total Yarding 1,598

Numbers were up slightly this week by 132 with 1545 liveweight and 53 calves for a total of 1598 head.

A mixed Quality Yarding today with a greater number of heavy steers and store steers on offer but otherwise a similar break up of categories to last week. The market was around 10c weaker across most categories with the usual gallery of buyer's in attendance.

Local Vealer steers were making from 320c to 650c and vealer heifers sold up to 518c/kg. Yearling steers selling from 360c to 508c while yearling heifers sold up to 450c/kg.

Grown steers were selling from 334c to 384c and Grown heifers sold from 280c to 410c. Light weight cows were making 100c to 160c, medium cows selling up to 306c while heavy cows returned 240c to 330c/kg

Mature heavy bulls sold up to 270c and shipping bulls from 240c to 460c for the heavier types and up to 500c/kg for the light weights.
