



MUCHEASHEEP AND LAMB REPORT 01/11/22

Total Yarding: 4,841–Down 545Sheep: 3,395Lambs: 1,446

Numbers were similar to last week with 545 less for a total of 4841 head. 517 new season lambs were presented with only a few pens of finished condition lambs as well as some tail end store lambs. Good runs of Merino mutton were on offer with plenty of interest from restockers. Prices remained firm across most categories with Some fresh faces in restocker buyers showing interest in Younger X-bred and Dorper rams.

New season store lambs made from \$43 to \$85 while light lambs were selling from \$60 to \$100/head. Trade lambs returned \$90 to \$124 and heavy lambs sold up to \$139. Ram lambs made up to \$100 and old season Merino lambs were selling from \$70 to \$120/head

Merino wether hoggets sold up to \$121 while Merino ewe hoggets up \$130. X-bred hoggets sold for \$50 to \$110 and younger rams were selling to \$80

Boner ewes made \$30 to 50, medium ewes were selling up to \$91 and heavy ewes sold up to \$108. Mature rams were making up to \$61/head
